Registration Information

- ★ March 15, 2008: Deposit of \$100 per person will be required to make a reservation for camp.
- ★ June 2, 2008: The balance of \$199 per person is due.
At this time, you are responsible for payment in full for the number registered at this date.
- ★ If you cancel on or before March 14, 2008, you will receive a full refund of your deposit.

CAMP SPOTS WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED UNTIL A SIGNED *FINANCIAL INFORMATION AND POLICY FORM* IS RECEIVED ALONG WITH THE MONEY AND REGISTRATION FORM.

Please read the *FINANCIAL INFORMATION AND POLICY* carefully, sign it, and have your senior pastor sign it. Keep a copy for your files and return a signed copy with this form and your deposit.

- ★ Final Deadline for registration is June 2, 2008. If the camp fills before that, your registration will be returned. You can call to make sure space is available.

Total Cost

Total camp cost is \$299 per person (students and leaders). T-shirts are included in the cost.

Length of Camp

Camp begins with registration on Sunday and concludes with breakfast on Saturday. Registration will begin at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. Lodging is provided beginning Sunday night. Sunday Dinner and Monday breakfast will be available by purchase of meal tickets in advance. Lunch will be on your own off campus. The first meal provided on campus included in the camp fee is Monday dinner. Monday is a free day for your group to enjoy the beach, a water park, amusement park or whatever you choose.

Age Requirement of Campers

Entering seventh grade this fall through newly graduated seniors in high school.

Leaders

Leaders must be at least 21 years of age. Please bring at least one leader per eight students. The church is responsible for selecting responsible and spiritually mature leaders. These leaders will be responsible for leading nightly church devotions, participating in recreation and worship activities, assisting their youth in matters of discipline, dress, curfew, and spiritual matters.

Health Forms/Medical Release Forms

Health/Medical Release Forms will be available on the CD sent to each church. Each student and leader must fill out a form. It is MANDATORY that these forms are brought to camp at check-in. No student or leader will be permitted to stay at camp without a completed Health/Medical Release form.
